

# Your kids will want to gobble up candy from this adorable Turkey Pot

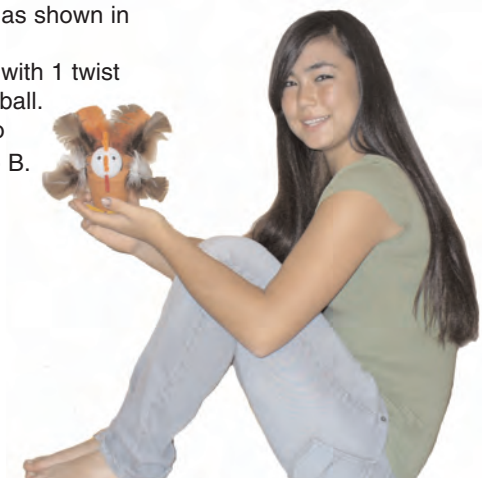


## What you need:

- 3 1/2 inch clay pot
- Chenille sticks (1 red, 1 yellow, 1 Orange)
- 2" styrofoam ball
- Craft feathers
- Character eyes
- Hot Glue gun & Glue sticks

## What you do:

1. Cut orange chenille stick in half. Bend 1 piece into shape as shown in figure A to make beak.
2. Twist long ends together with 1 twist and poke into styrofoam ball.
3. Bend the other piece into shape as shown in figure B. Do not twist ends.



Poke ends into top of head about 1/2 inch apart.

4. Cut red chenille stick in half. Bend as in fig B, Poke into head underneath beak.
5. Glue on eyes. Press head onto rim of pot until indent is created. Remove and glue in place.
6. Cut yellow chenille stick in half. Bend as shown in fig B. Make 2. Hot glue to underneath bottom of pot to make feet.
7. Glue feathers around back rim of pot and 2 on each side to create wings. Fill with goodies.

## Styrofoam Turkey

**What you need:** Use same supplies as needed for Turkey Pot, but substitute 3 1/2 " clay pot for 4" styrofoam egg and brown craft paint.

Paint Ball and Egg brown. Follow the same steps as above to make head. Glue head to body. Poke feet into body. Poke feathers into body to make tail and wings.
