

Heart Necklace



What could say “I love you” more than a hand-made heart- shaped necklace?

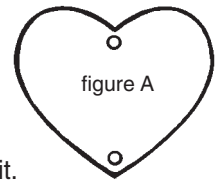
What you need:

- Pre cut wooden heart shape
- 2 large Beads (Make sure beads have hole large enough to fit 6 strands of cord through)
- 6 medium Beads
- 1 pkg satin cord
- 1 pkg hemp cord
- Small beads (enough to fill 6 strands of cord, approx 1 1/2” long ea.)
- Craft paint (We used red and metallic gold)
- Drill

We found all of our supplies at Michaels.

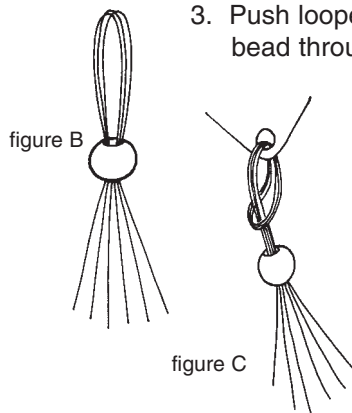
What you do:

1. Drill holes in wooden heart as shown (figure A) being very careful to drill slowly so wood won't split.
2. Paint heart (we kept ours simple: solid red with gold dots around edge) Let dry.



Making Tassel

1. Cut 3 pieces of hemp cord approx 12” in length. Fold in half, all together.
2. Insert folded strands through large bead, pulling loop end through about 3 inches. (Figure B)



3. Push looped end through hole in bottom of heart. then insert bead through loop and pull tight. (Figure C)

4. String small beads onto all 6 strands of hemp cord, ending with 1 medium bead on each strand. Tie knots on end. You may need to double or triple the knot to keep bead from coming off.
5. Cut satin cord to desired length.
6. Fold in half and insert through 2nd large bead
7. Attach through hole in top of heart the same way as tassel. Make knot at end.
