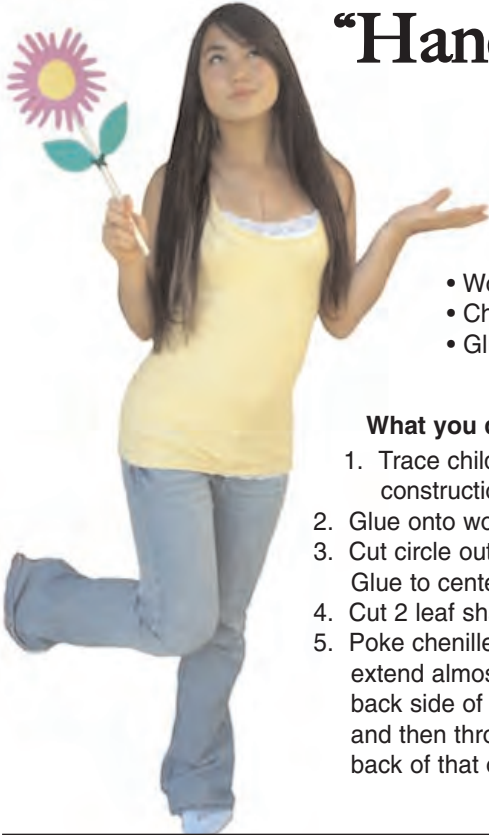


# “Handy” Plant Stake



## What you need:

- Construction Paper (bright color for petals, yellow for center green for leaves)
- Wooden Spoon
- Chenille stick (preferably green)
- Glue

## What you do:

1. Trace child's hands 6 times on bright construction paper. Cut out each hand.
2. Glue onto wooden spoon in shape of flower
3. Cut circle out of yellow construction paper  
Glue to center of flower.
4. Cut 2 leaf shapes out of green paper.
5. Poke chenille stick through corner of leaf and extend almost the length of the leaf. Glue to back side of leaf. Twist around stem (spoon) and then through the other leaf, gluing to the back of that one also. Clip off excess chenille.
