

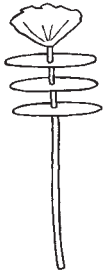
# Tissue Flower Bouquet

## What you need:

- Several colors of Tissue Paper
- Green Chenille Sticks
- Scissors

## What you do:

1. Layer tissue paper in several colors. We used 12 total layers for each flower (4 layers each of 3 contrasting colors)
2. Cut the layers in to a circle approximately 4" in diameter.
3. Bend tip of chenille stick into a small ball.
4. Poke unbent end through the center of the cut circles.
5. One by one, slide the circle up to the balled end of the chenille stick and give it a good scrunch. (as shown below)
6. Poof the flower with your fingers after all layers have been scrunched.



Make several and group them together for a beautiful Bouquet
