

Fleece Hat

It just doesn't get any cuter than this!



You won't even believe how easy this hat is to make!

What you need:

- 1/2 yard Fleece Fabric
- Scissors
- Sewing Machine
- Needle & Thread
- Tape Measure

What you do:

1. Measure head
2. Cut a piece of fleece that is 16 inches wide and as long as the head measurement you took, plus 2 inches.
3. Fold fleece in half with right sides together so the 16 inch edges match up. Sew a 1/2 inch seam along the edge, stopping 5 inches from end.
4. Just below the last stitch, make a 1/2 inch cut in from the side (figure 1) Turn right side out.
5. Sew a 1/2 inch seam along the last 5 inches of unsewn fleece. (figure 2)
6. Cut slits approx 3/4 inch thick and 4 inches long into top edge of hat (figure 3)
7. Roll the bottom of the hat up 2 turns to create cuff, hiding the bottom part of the seam. Sew a couple of stitches just to keep the cuff from rolling down.
8. Cut a strip of fleece 1 inch thick and approx 24 inches long
9. Gather top edge of hat and tie with fleece strip.

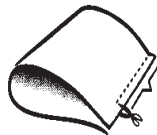

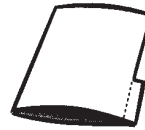
